To all my concerned Parishioners regarding protecting your family by promoting a more secure and prosperous life:

The Roman Catholic Church has a long history of supporting workers and workers' rights dating back two centuries to Pope Leo XIII. The Church's teachings tell us we are to support the dignity of every human including those that provide us with our basic needs whether it be providing our tables with fruits & vegetables, or providing a myriad of services from hospitality, cooking and serving food at our restaurants. In a 1996 statement by the U.S. Catholic Conference of Bishops (USCCB) "A Framework for Economic Life" they state 'institutions must be judged by how they protect the dignity...of the human person, support the family and serve the common good.'

I feel obliged to communicate to you, your right to organize and ask for workplace protections through representatives¹. Unions are a way for workers to negotiate for just wages, benefits and better working conditions, and to look after the rights of vulnerable workers, including those with injuries and disabilities ².
